Baumberger Endowment Turns 40!

The Baumberger Endowment was created to honor the wishes of Charles Baumberger, Jr., as expressed in his Last Will and Testament. He and his wife, Gene, had no children of their own and it was Mr. Baumberger's desire to provide scholarship funds for education in the basic arts and sciences to Texas' youth, specifically those in Bexar County. The Endowment is guided by specific requirements stated in Mr. Baumberger's Will and by policies set by the Trustees of the Endowment.

Mr. Baumberger was a lifetime resident of San Antonio and a former President of the Board of San Antonio Portland Cement Company. His father and grandfather were pioneer settlers in San Antonio, dating back to the 1850's, and his father was one of the founders of San Antonio Portland Cement Company and one of the organizers of Bexar County National Bank. The Baumbergers acquired much of their wealth from the manufacturing and production of cement.

Although Mr. Baumberger died in 1968 at age 79, his wife, Gene, lived until 1972, and the Endowment was established in 1979, after her death at age 66. Since then, approximately 3,410 scholarships totaling over \$49 million have been awarded, and those of us associated with the Endowment, hope we can continue Mr. Baumberger's legacy for many more years to come!
