## IRS Reminder

Don't forget scholarship amounts over the cost of tuition, course-related fees, books, supplies, and equipment will be considered taxable income when completing your 1040 forms for calendar year 2020. No IRS Forms W-2 or 1099 are being issued by Baumberger. Seek assistance from your financial aid office or a tax advisor, if necessary.

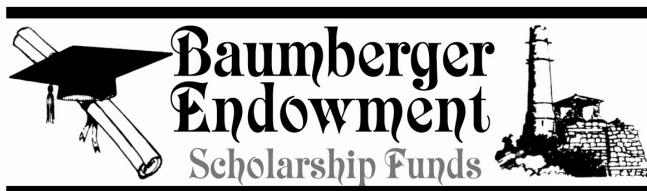
Search up, down, forward, backward, and on the diagonal to find the hidden words. After all the words have been found, circle the 5 remaining letters to reveal the hidden springtime word.
